· **DAY TICKETS in advance or on the day: Payment at the gate will be contactless.**

- BMFA/LMA/SVAS Members - £8.50 per day (with valid membership card)
- Adults (Spectators/Public) - £13.00 per day (No concessions); Children free
- Campers, please book your Day Tickets in advance.

· **CAMPING £15 per night, per unit, to be booked online, in advance.**

CAMPING INFORMATION

- Pitches are not unlimited and **pre-booking is essential**. Camping Fee per unit, per night: £15. You will be refunded on request if you are unable to come. Day tickets are not included in the camping fee; please book these in advance.
- **Parklands Campsite**: on arrival via the new road, please follow Campsite directions. On arrival, please contact the Campsite Manager, Janine: 07532 821966, and she will direct you to your pre-booked pitch. If your arrival is significantly delayed, please let her know.
- Please ensure that you have reserved your pitch in advance online, (although you cannot request a specific location).
- Please note that Parklands Campsite is classified as **Wild Camping** and facilities are accordingly limited. There is a fresh water supply, and a nearby Elsan point. There will be 4 Portaloos plus one disabled Portaloo, on the Campsite.
- Camping is available only for self-sufficient camping, ie tents, caravans, folding campers and motorhomes (due to Covid measures). All campers are asked to provide their own washing and toilet facilities if possible. The main toilet block adjacent to the hangars is open.
- Pitches are either 8mx8m or 10mx10m, allocation is first come first served, no VIP booking permitted.
- Water points and an Elsan point are available; PortaLoos have been requested in the campsite.
- Camping is available from 14:00 on Thursday until midday on Monday, for ModelAir events. If you wish to remain on site beyond midday, please pack up and move to the parking area by midday.
- Please note only Gas Barbeques are allowed in the campsite.
